STATE COURT ELECTRONIC CASE FILING UPDATE

ABOUT THE SEMINAR: Electronic filing is currently mandated in the Orange County's Complex Litigation Division and also Orange County's Circuit Civil Division. There have been some enhancements to the Electronic Case Filing ("ECF") system which you may not know about, including roll-out to other divisions. Also, Orange County's pilot testing of ECF has been the standard by which the Florida Supreme Court anticipates the approval of a statewide e-filing "portal" to ensure equal access to electronic filing across the entire state. By the end of 2010, it is expected that the majority of state courts in Florida will require electronic filing of court documents. Be ready to know how to electronically file your documents in any county.

SPEAKER: Carolyn M. Weber, Project Manager. Ms. Weber joined the Orange County Clerk of Courts January 2005 as the ECF Project Manager. Prior to joining Orange County, she worked for 22 years with the United States District Court. During Ms. Weber's time with the District Court, she worked ten of those years with the Honorable David A. Baker wherein Ms. Weber created, developed and implemented throughout the United States an Automated Document Production program endorsed by the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts. Ms. Weber attended Florida State University and has a BS in Computer Science with an MBA in Computer Information Systems. She received her Project Management Certificate from the University of Florida in 2007.
