Advanced Legal Writing: "POLISHING FOR PROFESSIONALS WORKSHOP"

SPEAKER: Brooke J. Bowman, Professor of Legal Skills and Moot Court Advisor, Stetson Law. Professor Brooke J. Bowman teaches Research and Writing I and II, Advanced Legal Research and Legal Drafting classes, as well as the Polishing for Professionals workshop. She is also the coordinator of the Scholarly Writing Series.

TOPIC: The writing process contains four stages: pre-writing, drafting, revising, and polishing. This Workshop will focus on the fourth and final stage of the writing process: polishing. Because written documents make an impression on the reader, the polishing of a document is extremely important. With that said, the polishing stage is the stage that most professional legal writers skip or delegate to their assistants or paralegals. This workshop will help each participant—each developing legal writer—to identify the participants’s areas of opportunity (or challenges) in polishing and to learn strategies and tips and tricks for polishing.
