While at the Department of Children and Families she was also responsible for the termination of parental rights cases for three counties. Ms. Savitz has also done extensive appellate work including oral argument before the Fifth District Court of Appeal and the Florida Supreme Court. She currently is a Senior Attorney with The Florida Bar in the Lawyer Regulation division in the Orlando office. As Bar Counsel with The Florida Bar, she reviews and handles inquiry/complaints and is bar counsel for three grievance committees. She is actively involved with The Florida Bar was a member of the Juvenile Rules Committee from 1993 through 2003. Ms. Savitz has also participated regularly in programs such as Teen Court, Mock Trial, and the We The People Competition for the past several years. Ms. Savitz was the recipient of the 2005 Pro Bono Award for Government Attorneys from the Legal Aid Society and the Orange County Bar Association.
